

The rebate program

The Skagit County Public Health Department received a grant from the Washington State Department of Ecology to offer \$100 rebates for septic system inspections and/or installation of risers and lids. The purpose of *The Septic System Improvement Pilot Project* is to increase awareness of the need for routine septic system inspections and to promote access and routine maintenance. Many areas of Skagit County's marine and fresh waters have been impacted by failed septic systems. Routine inspections help prevent failures which ultimately protects public health and water quality.

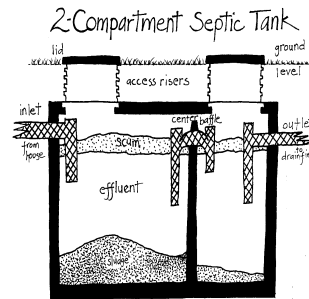
The Rebate Program: How it works

To qualify and receive your rebate you must:

1. Have a private residence in Skagit County and reside in an area of water quality concern such as certain marine shorelines and watersheds. Examples include Skagit, Padilla and Samish Bays, Hansen, Nookachamps and Fisher Creeks to name a few.
2. Attend a **free** Septics 101 Clinic: held frequently and previous attendance will qualify!
3. Have the inspection and/or installation done by a Skagit County certified maintenance specialist (list available online or call the Health Dept.).
4. Pay for the services and keep your receipt/paid invoice.
5. Submit the application with documentation of the work done to the Health Dept.

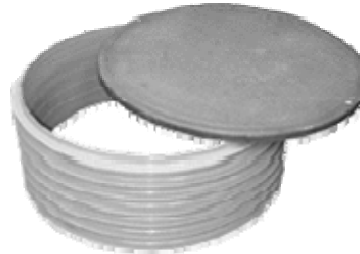
You will receive the rebate in approximately three weeks.

\$100 Rebate for Installation of Lids and Risers



Water/vapor tight lids and risers allow easy and secure access to tanks

The small print- Conditions that apply:

1. Only one rebate per inspection and/or riser/lid installation; up to \$200.
2. Rebate for work done only after July 1, 2005.
3. Rebates not allowed for pumping of tanks.
4. For private residences only.
