NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Contract Documents have been modified as follows:

Line Item #2 of the Proposal:

The item Minor Changes is in the amount of \$15,000.00. Please replace the first page of the bid proposal with the attached new page.

General Information:

1. The Galvanized Multi-Plate Culvert has been purchased and assembled by County staff. The culvert is currently located at the County Road Shop, 201 East Avon Avenue, Burlington, WA 98233 and may be viewed at that location.
2. The County will not be hosting a pre-bid meeting, all contractors are encouraged to visit the project site and view the culvert.

Page 49 of the Contract Provisions and Plans

The paragraph starting on line 9 is revised to read: Contractor shall remove a section of Water Main in order to allow the installation of the Multi-Plate Pipe-Arch Culvert. Contractor shall notify the engineer, 10 working days prior to the removal of the Water Main, before the water may be shut off. **The contractor shall have the Water Main replaced and operational within 3 days after it is shut off.** If the Water Main is not operational at that time liquidated damages shall accrue against the Contractor at a rate of \$1500.00 per day. Samish Farms Water Association Inc. shall provide the Contractor all pipe and pipe fittings required to replace the removed section of Water Main. Contractor shall then replace the section of Water Main after the installation of the Multi-Plate Pipe-Arch culvert per the requirements of Division 7.

Appendix C: Permits and Reports

1. Item number 14 on page two (2) of the Hydraulic Project Approval shall be deleted and revised to read: The native material that is present shall be used to fill the pipe to the appropriate depth as normally required.
