PROPOSITION NO. 1  
BURLINGTON-EDISON SCHOOL  
DISTRICT NO. 100  
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS -  
\$74,000,000

The Board of Directors of Burlington-Edison School District No. 100 approved Resolution No. 726 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to modernize Burlington-Edison High School, construct and equip two new elementary schools, acquire land, refinance existing bonds and make other capital improvements; to issue \$74,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years; and to levy additional property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution #726.
