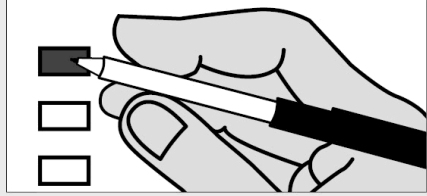

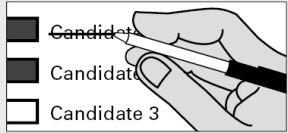

The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill. This bill would expand the rights, responsibilities, and obligations accorded state-registered same-sex and senior domestic partners to be equivalent to those of married spouses, except that a domestic partnership is not a marriage. Restoring Regular Property Tax Levy  
The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 4, Skagit County, Washington adopted Resolution No. 408 authorizing a regular property tax levy of \$1.00 per \$1,000, which is less than the levy that existed in the year 2004. This proposition would authorize the District to restore and maintain its regular property tax levy of \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2009 and thereafter subject to any otherwise applicable statutory dollar rate limitations. The dollar amount of this levy would be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for subsequent levies under RCW 84.55.050. Should this proposal be approved?
