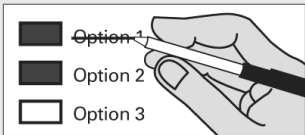
How to vote

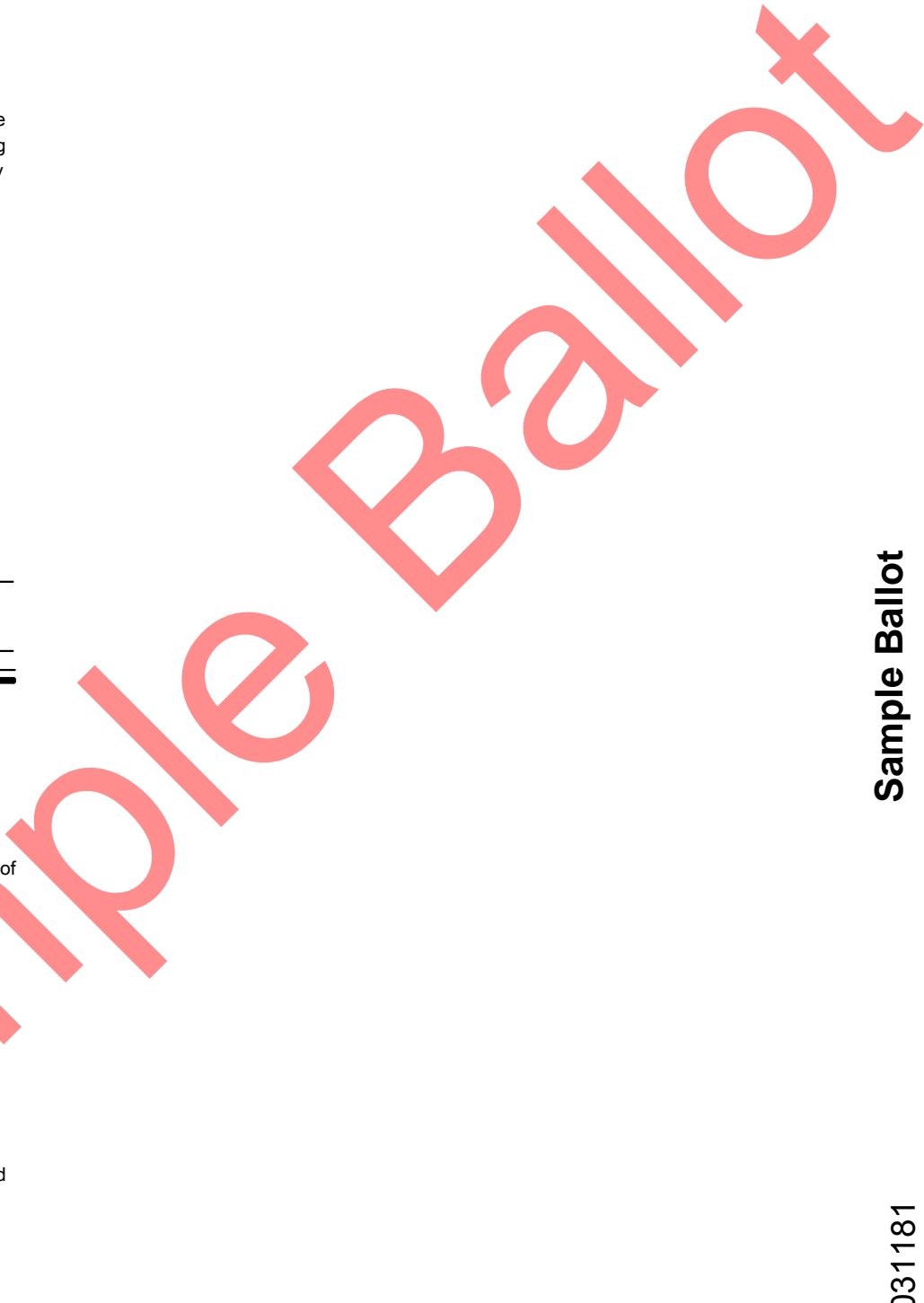
