The Board of Directors of Burlington-Edison School District No. 100 approved a proposition for bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to: construct a new 7-8 Middle School, relocate Alternative High School, add High School classrooms, make security improvements at District schools, including the High School, construct a new gymnasium and food service facility at West View Elementary; issue up to \$98,300,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution #836.
