Proposition No. 1 Public Safety Staffing

The Anacortes City Council adopted Resolution 3103 concerning funding to improve public safety service levels and response times. This proposition would provide funding for five additional police officers and eight additional firefighter/medics by establishing a maximum regular property tax levy of \$1.34335/\$1000 of assessed valuation in 2023 for collection in 2024 (an estimated increase of approximately \$0.36240/\$1000). The 2024 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for subsequent levies under RCW 84.55.

Proposition No. 1 Levy Lid Lift for Health Care Services

The Commission of Skagit County Public Hospital District No. 1, Skagit County, Washington (Skagit Regional Health) adopted Resolution No. 4279 concerning the district's regular property tax levy. If approved, this proposition would provide additional funds for hospital and other health care services including primary care, specialty care, surgical care, emergency care, and urgent care services. It authorizes a maximum regular property levy rate for collection in 2024 of 50 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value. The 2024 levy amount will be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for levies in subsequent years.
