RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

For and in consideration of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, to it in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter recited, THE PACIFIC TOW BOAT COMPANY, a corporation, (hereinafter referred to as Grantor) does hereby grant and convey to THE TEXAS COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns (hereinafter referred to as Grantee), the right to construct a trestle and lay, maintain, operate and remove pipe lines thereupon for the transportation of cil, gas, petroleum products, water, and any other substance, and erect, maintain and operate a telephone or telegraph line, if the same should be found necessary, over and through tidelands owned by Grantor, situate on the easterly portion of Fidalgo Bay contiguous to the shoreline thereof in Skagit County, State of Washington, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land 80 feet wide, the easterly line of which is the westerly line of the new County road known as March's Point and Burrows Bay Road; the southern boundary of said 80 foot strip being a line 80 feet long lying N 89° 35' W from a point in Government Lot 7 in Section 32, T 35 N, R 2 E, W.
