ORDINANCE NO. 1799

AN ORDINANCE vacating certain street right-of-ways abutting Blocks 912, 913, 914, and 915, in Northern Pacific Addition to the City of Anacortes.

WHEREAS, a petition praying for the vacation of the below described property was filed with the City Clerk by owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon that portion of said road right-of-way sought to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution fixed the time and place for hearing of said petition, and more than twenty days prior to the date of said hearing notice of the same was duly published and posted according to law; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was duly held and it appears to be in the best interest of the City of Anacortes to grant said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANACORTES, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following described streets located in Northern Pacific Addition to the City of Anacortes and abutting Blocks 912, 913, 914, and 915, of said Addition, be and they are hereby declared vacated:

Illinois Avenue from the South line of West 6th Street to the South line of West 8th Street; West 7th Street, from the East line of Kansas Ave. to the East line of Illinois Avenue; West 8th Street, from the East line of Kansas Avenue to the East line of Illinois Avenue.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after five days after its passage and publication as required by law.
