Which interest shall be in addition to each \$2,000.00 payment applied in reduction of principal. All payments to be made hereunder shall be made at 1476 Country Club Drive, Burlington, WA 98233, or at such other place as the Seller may direct in writing.

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Any principal payments made in excess of \$2,000.00 each year may, at purchaser's option, accrue to the principal amount due in any following year or years, except that these excess payments may not be so accrued in excess of five (5) future payments at any one time (\$10,000.00). Payments of interest are to be timely made each and every year.
- The Purchaser is to pay all of the 1980 Real Estate taxes without pro-rate.
- 3. The insurance requirement under #2, below, is waived and this paragraph is to be aeleted.
- ** 4. The Seller, or his successor in interest, may at his discretion vary the interest rate from not less than 4% to not more than 8%.

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As referred to in this contract, "date of closing" shall be April 1, 1980.

- hereafter become a lien on said real estate; and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.
- (2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on said real estate insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to
- (3) The purchaser agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or agreement for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenant or agreement relied on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.
- (4). The purenaser assumes all hazards of damage to or destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed thereon, and of the taking of said real estate or any part thereof for public use, and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration. In case any part of said real estate is taken for public use, the portion of the condemnation award remaining after payment of reasonable expenses of procuring the same shall be paid to the seller and applied as payment on the purchase peace herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchaser to apply all or a portion of such condemnation award to the rebuilding or restoration of any improvements damaged by such tiking. In case of damage or destruction from a peril insured against, the proceeds of such insurance remaining after payment of the reasonable expense of procuring the same shall be devoted to the restoration or rebuilding of such improvements within a reasonable time, unless putchaser elects that said proceeds shall be paid to the seller for application on the
- (5) The sector has delivered, or agrees to deliver within 15 days of the date of closing, a purchaser's policy of title insurance in standard form, or a commutment therefor, issued by monotomerical thinks of distributions of insuring the purchaser to the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage by reason of detect in seller's title to said real estate as of the date of closing and containing no exceptions other than the following:
 - a. Printed general exceptions appearing in said policy form;
 - b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and
 - C. Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which selier by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.

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(6) If seller's title to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, er any mortrage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

(7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following:

2. Easement for gas pipeline in favor of Cascade Natural Gas Corporation recorded October 30, 1956, under Auditor's No. 543543 affecting a 50 foot right of way.

(5) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements an said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purposer covenants to pur all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(2) In case the purchaser falls to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the seller may make such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without prejudice to any other right the seller mucht have by reason of such default

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the sel'er may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no waiver by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be construed as a water of any subsequent delault.

Service upon purchaser of all demands, notices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by Un. of States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon se'ler's election to bring suit to enforce any covenant of this contract, including suit to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such sult, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.

If the seller shall bring suit to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, and judgment is so entered, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also the reasonable cust of searching records to determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be
