AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEYS LOCATED IN BLOCK 3, 4, 5, AND 6, ~~SHIP HARBOR ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ANACORTES~~ "FIRST PLAT OF SHIP HARBOR".

WHEREAS, a petition praying for the vacation of the below described property was filed with the City Clerk by owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon that portion of said property sought to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by resolution fixed the time and place for hearing of said petition, and more than twenty (20) days prior to the date of said hearing notice of the same was duly published and posted according to law; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was duly held and the City Council of the City of Anacortes finds that the granting of said vacation is in the public interest and the best interests of the City of Anacortes; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANACORTES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Those alleys located in Blocks 3, 4, 5, and 6, ~~Ship Harbor Addition to the City of Anacortes~~ be and they are hereby declared to be vacated. "First Plat of Ship Harbor"

Section 2. This Ordinance shall not become effective until the owners of the property abutting upon the above described property shall compensate the City of Anacortes in an amount which equals one-half appraised value of the area so vacated.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be published until the payments specified in Section 2 have been made and shall become effective and be in force from and after five (5) days after its publication as provided by law.
