LEGAL DESCRIPTION

That portion of Government Lot Eight (8) in Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Four (4) East of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Section 18; thence S 840 31' 04"W along the South line of said Section 18, a distance of 537.12 ft.; thence N 31° 32' 32"E along a line which is parallel to and 7.35 ft. Southeasterly of and measured at right angles to the centerline of the Mount Vernon Terminal Railway Company right-of-way, a distance of 277.41 ft.; thence N 580 271 28"W, a distance of 8.49 ft. to the True Point Of Beginning of this property description; thence N 310 321 32"E and parallel with the Westerly line of said Mount Vernon Terminal Railway Company right-of-way, a distance of 300.00 ft.; thence N 580 27' 28"W, a distance of 8.86 ft.; thence N 31° 32' 32"E along a line which is parallel to and 40.00 ft. Southeasterly of and measured at right angles to the Westerly line of said Railway right-of-way, a distance of 132.48 ft. to a point on the Southerly line of that 100 ft. wide abandoned Puget Sound And Cascade Railway right-of-way as conveyed to Claude 0.
