AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2163,
PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 15TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1990, AND
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREET
RIGHT OF WAYS AND ALLEY RIGHT OF WAY
LOCATED IN THE FIRST PLAT OF SHIPS HARBOR ADDITION
TO THE CITY OF ANACORTES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2163 was passed and approved on the
15th day of October, 1990; and

WHEREAS, some of the individuals who originally petitioned
for vacation of street right of ways have subsequently decided
not to proceed with said vacation and it is now necessary to
amend the description of the areas being vacated; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANACORTES, WASHINGTON does
ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2163, passed and
approved on the 15th day of October, 1990, and entitled "An
ordinance vacating certain street right of ways and alley right
of way located in the First Plat of Ships Harbor to the City of
Anacortes", be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The following described public right of ways
located in the City of Anacortes be and they are hereby
declared to be vacated:

The Southerly 30 feet of B Street abutting Lot 16, Block 6,
and the Northerly one-half of Harrison Avenue abutting Lot
9, Block 6, First Plat of Ships Harbor to Anacortes; and
westerly one-half of the alley abutting Lots 9, 10, and 11
of Block 11, First Plat of Ships Harbor to Anacortes; the
Southerly one-half of Harrison Street abutting Lot 16, Block
10 and extending fifty (50) feet along the north line of
said Lot 16, Block 10, if extended, to the intersection with
the centerline of Morton Avenue and the Easterly one-half of
Morton Avenue butting Lots 14, 15, and 16, Block 10 and the
westerly one-half of that alley abutting Lots 11, 12, 13,
14, 15 and 16 of Block 10, and that portion of the Southerly
one-half of Harrison Avenue abutting upon the Westerly one-
half of the alley abutting Lot 16, Block 10, all within the
First Plat of Ships Harbor to Anacortes; the Southerly one-
half of D Street lying easterly of the West line of Lot 1,
Block 15, First Plat of Ships Harbor to Anacortes, if
extended, to the centerline of 2nd Street, First Plat of
Ships Harbor to Anacortes, if extended, and that portion of
2nd Street lying between the abutting Lots 1 through 4 of
Block 15 and Lots 13 through 16 of Block 16, First Plat of
ships Harbor to Anacortes.

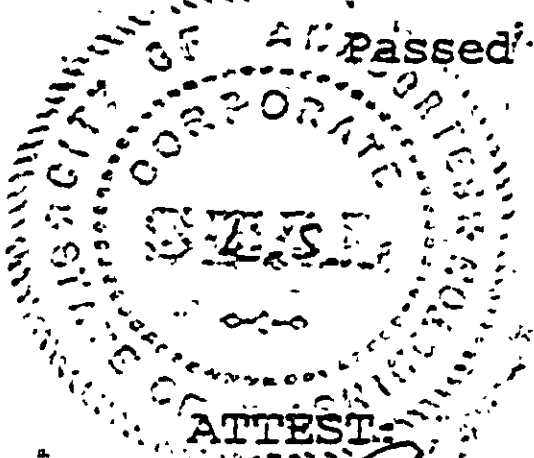
