AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT CERTAIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY LYING  
NORTHERLY OF AND ADJACENT TO BLOCK 1, G. KELLOGG'S ADDITION TO  
THE TO THE CITY OF ANACORTES, RECORDS OF SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, the City Council has held public hearing regarding  
a petition to vacate the below described property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the vacation  
of the below described property is in the best interest of the  
City of Anacortes and that a public benefit exist to justify said  
vacation in that the area being vacated is too small to be  
utilized by the public as a utility easement or as a alley or  
roadway easement, a vacation will allow the property being  
vacated to be placed on the tax roles, and the City will not have  
any additional obligation to maintain said area; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THE CITY OF  
ANACORTES, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. The following described right of way be and it  
is hereby vacated subject only to the conditions contained in  
Section 2 hereof: That certain right of way located north of and  
adjacent to lots 11-20, Block 1, G. Kellogg's addition to the  
City of Anacortes, records of Skagit County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall not be published  
or recorded until the owners of the property abutting to the  
south has compensated the City of Anacortes in an amount equal to  
one half of the appraised value of the property being vacated.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take affect and be  
enforced from and after five (5) days after its passage and  
publication as required by law.
