ALL OF JACKSON STREET, AS SAID STREET IS SHOWN ON THE "PLAT OF RESERVE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MONTBORNE", IN SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS PER PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS, PAGE 59, LYING SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF THERESE STREET SHOWN THEREON AND THAT PORTION OF THE 100 FOOT WIDE RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY (AND ORIGINALLY CONVEYED TO THE SEATTLE LAKE SHORE AND EASTERN RAILWAY) LYING BETWEEN THE NORTHWESTERLY AND SOUTHEASTERLY LINES OF JACKSON STREET EXTENDÉD SOUTHWESTERLY AND LYING NORTHEASTERLY OF LINE "RR" DESCRIBED BELOW.

THE NORTHWESTERLY HALF OF HANCOCK STREET AS SAID STREET IS SHOWN ON THE "PLAT OF RESERVE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MONTBORNET, IN SKAGIT COUNTY WASHINGTON, AS PER PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS, PAGE 59, AND THE ABUTTING RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY (AND ORIGINALLY CONVEYED TO THE SEATTLE LAKESHORE AND EASTERN RAILWAY) LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTH LINE OF THERESE AVENUE AND LINE "RR". DESCRIBED BELOW. TOGETHÉR WITH LOTS 1 THROUGH 10 OF BLOCK 5, "PLAT OF RESERVE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MONTBORNE", AS PER PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 OF PLATS, PAGE 59, RECORDS OF SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

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
BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 6 OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 33 NORTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M., WHICH IS MIDWAY BETWEEN THE CENTERLINE OF THE ORIGINAL 100 FOOT WIDE RIGHT, OF WAY OF SEATTLE LAKE SHORE AND EASTERN RAILWAY AND THE CENTERLINE OF THE LAST MAINLINE TRACK OF THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY AS IT EXISTED IN 1970: THENCE NORTHERLY ON A LINE DRAWN MIDWAY BETWEEN THE CENTERLINE OF THE ORIGINAL 100 FOOT RIGHT OF WAY AND THE CENTERLINE OF THE ABOVE DESCRIBED MAINLINE TRACT TO THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF SAID CENTERLINES, SAID POINT BEING THE TERMINUS OF THIS LINE DESCRIPTION.
