SURVEY DESCRIPTION

PARCEL "A":

That portion of the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 36 North, Range 3 East, W.M., described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the West line of said Southeast 1/4, 437.52 feet North of the Southwest corner thereof;

thence continue North 1° 10′ 51" East along said West line a distance of 1014.18 feet;

thence South 88° 49' 09" East a distance of 661.07 feet; thence South 1° 09' 41" West a distance of 202.55 feet; thence South 88° 50' 19" East a distance of 661.14 feet; thence South 1° 08' 31" West a distance of 330.00 feet thence North 88° 50' 35" West a distance of 661.25 feet thence South 1° 09' 42" West a distance of 486.00 feet thence North 88° 26' 13" West a distance of 661.43 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Tract "I"; thence North 1° 10′ 51" East 233.14 feet along the West line of said Tract "I" to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence North 27° 29′ 17" East 73.75 feet; thence North 11° 44′ 24" West 146.77 feet to the West line of said Tract "I" at a point bearing North 1° 10′ 51" East from the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 1° 10′ 51" West 208.58 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

thence South 1° 09' 41" West a distance of 202.55 feet;

thence South 88° 50' 19" East a distance of 661.14 feet;

thence North 1° 08' 31" East a distance of 75.55 feet; thence South 89° 07' 04" East a distance of 466.47 feet;

thence North 36° 37' 06" West a distance of 254.44 feet;

thence North 46° 31' 17" West a distance of 254.44 feet;

thence North 57° 07' 28" West a distance of 372.50 feet:

thence North 61° 37' 29" West a distance of 720.29 feet;

thence North 61° 38' 33" West a distance of 94.02 feet;

thence North 77° 59' 24" West a distance of 142.06 feet;

thence South 86° 58' 23" West a distance of 119.60 feet;

thence South 72° 54' 29" West a distance of 98.32 feet;

thence South 52° 02' 29" West a distance of 141.01 feet to the West line of said Southwest 1/4;

thence South 1° 10′ 51" West a distance of 660.75 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

NOTES

- 1. All maintenance and construction of private roads are the responsibility of the lot owners and the responsibility of maintenance shall be in direct relationship to usage of road. (See Skagit County Roadway Variance No. 94-012 and Easement and Maintenance Document recorded under Auditor's File No. 9309030006.)
- 2. Short Plat Number and Date of Approval shall be included in all deeds and contracts.
- 3. Zoning Rural
 - Sewage Disposal Individual septic system. (Alternative Systems)

 Alternative on-site sewage disposal systems may have special design, construction and maintenance requirements. See Skagit County Health Department for details.
- 5. Water Individual Wells

Water will be supplied from individual water systems. Contact the Health Department to determine if additional water quality or quantity testing will be required for building permit approvals. Skagit County code requires a 100-foot radius well protection zone for new individual water systems. The zone must be contained entirely on the lot owned in fee simple and/or be provided through appropriate covenants or easements. Present and future owners of lots with an existing well shall preserve a 100-foot radius well protection zone for existing well improvement or replacement. An aquifer demonstration well was located on Lot 1.
