

WATER SUPPLY



SEWAGE DISPOSAL

The method of sewage disposal shall be by Individual septic drainfield systems. Lots A and B are undeveloped at this time, i.e. there are no existing residences. The required soil logs for Lot A of this Short Plat have been previously submitted by Northwest Septic, dated April 8, 1992 as received by the Skagit County Permit Center for the John Standish Short Plat No. 92-025. Additional soil logs for Lot B of this Short Plat were also recently completed by Northwest Septic, Inc. on January 8, 1996 for Robert Suttles. All soil logs are currently on file with the Skagit County Permit Center.

- I. The short plat number and date of approval shall be included in all deeds and contracts.
- 2. This short plat is further subject to the notes on the face of Skagit County Short Plat No. 92-025.
- 3. All necessary maintenance and improvements of roadway, commonly referred to as Sahale Drive, shall be shared on a proportionate basis based upon the number of property owners entitled to usage and as specifically provided by that instrument entitled "ROADWAY EASEMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT" as recorded October 31, 1980 under Auditor's File No. 8010310003, records of Skagit County, Washington.
- 4. Alternative on-site sewage disposal system may have special design, construction and maintenance requirements. See Skagit County Health Officer for details.
- 5. No building permit shall be issued for any residential and/or commercial structures which are not, at the time of application, determined to be within an official designated boundary of a Skagit County Fire District.
