DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence, acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270. The drinking water drilled well source for this project requires filtration treatment to remove fluoride, therefore:

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and I have no objection nor will I make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. The drinking water for this residential building is served by a drilled well that is over the maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 4.0 mg/l for fluoride and requires filtration. Raw water samples showed a fluoride concentration between 9.95 and 8.1 mg/l during 1996 and 1997. To prevent dental fluorosis (mottled enamel), fluoride concentrations in drinking water should be less than 2 mg/l. When functioning properly, the reverse osmosis (RO) filter units under each sink will remove most dissolved solids in the water, including fluoride. On October 13, 1997, the fluoride concentration following the RO unit was measured at .82 mg/l.
4. Filtration is provided by the following system, in order: one 25 micron cartridge filter, 1400 gallons of storage, one 5 micron cartridge filter, one 1 micron bag filter, one .5 micron cartridge filter, followed by reverse osmosis filter under each sink prior to the faucet. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by having spare filters available at all times, testing for fluoride periodically and providing appropriate maintenance to the filtration and reverse osmosis units as directed by the manufacturer(s). In addition, water conservation and testing for bacteria periodically is recommended.
5. **Properties with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as justification for the creation of new lots and cannot be further subdivided unless an approved public system or approved drilled well becomes available.** Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health or Permit Center.
