**DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT**

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270 in regards to the drinking water source which is an alternative source other than a drilled well requiring filtration and disinfection treatment.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. A ten-foot deep dug serves the drinking water for this residential building well that with a eight-foot concrete surface seal as per WAC 173-160. It requires both filtration and disinfection to make the drinking water consistent and sanitary. Filtration and disinfection are provided by the following system: one 20-micron-cartridge filter, one 5-micron-cartridge filter, ultraviolet disinfection unit (for bacteria and viral particles), followed by a one micron cartridge filter prior to drinking. Poor water clarity (turbidity) may indicate that pathogens may be present at times in the drinking water. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
  - a. conserving drinking water use where possible by installing low water use landscaping and fixtures,
  - b. having spare ultraviolet light bulbs and changing the lights annually,
  - c. having spare cartridge filters and maintaining an operation and maintenance log,
  - d. testing for turbidity during times of poor water clarity,
  - e. testing for bacteria on a quarterly basis and
  - f. providing appropriate maintenance to the filtration and disinfection units as directed by the manufacturer.
4. Properties with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as justification for the creation of new lots and can not be further subdivided.
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health.
