The Declaration under the terms, covenants and provisions of which liability for said charges, assessments, interest and collection costs arises was recorded on (I: June 11, 1974/II: July 1, 1975/III: June 7, 1977) under Auditor's File No. (I: 802096/II: 819946/III: 857759), records of Skagit County, Washington, and provides that any lien therein provided for shall be superior to any and all other liens at any time levied or imposed upon such real property.


