I FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. There are no genuine issues of material fact presented and the issues raised on the competing Motions for Summary Judgment are ripe for determination.

Hereinafter referred to as the "Property."

- 3. The Property is a portion of real estate generally described as 1208 Fourth Street, Anacortes, Washington (hereinafter referred to as the "Entire Site").
- 4. Title to the Property was contested in the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington. The Federal District Court quieted title to the Property in the United States based on alternate theories of adverse possession and implied easement. The United States then sold the Property to Hughes-Northwest, Inc., defendant in the present proceeding. Spahi appealed the District Court's decision. The United States Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit, in <u>United States v. Spahi</u>, 177 F.3d 748 (1999), reversed the District Court and held that the United States had no interest in the Property. The United States Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit, additionally held that Hughes-Northwest, Inc., was not a bona fide purchaser for value and, because it acquired title from the United States by quitclaim deed, Hughes-Northwest, Inc. acquired only the United State's interest in the Property subject to valid title claims.

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Court enters the following:

II CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

- 1. The Court has personal jurisdiction over Hughes-Northwest, Inc., and has subject matter jurisdiction over questions of title to real property located in Skagit County, Washington.
- 2. Defendant should be and hereby is collaterally estopped from arguing that it is a good faith purchaser or that it did not take title from the United States subject to valid title claims.
- 3. Title to the Property described in Finding of Fact No. 2, above, should be and hereby is quieted in the name of Nader Spahi, d/b/a Emperor West Associates, a sole proprietorship.
- 4. Defendant, and its successors, if any, should be forever barred from asserting any right, title, interest, estate, or lien in or to the Property described in Finding of Fact No. 2, above.
- 5. Defendant, its successors, assigns, grantees or lessees, should be and hereby are ejected from physically occupying the Property described in Finding of Fact No. 2, above.
- 6. Other issues raised in Plaintiff's Complaint in this action, including but not limited to damages and implied easement, should be and hereby are reserved for trial.
- 7. Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment should be and hereby is denied.
