PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY UTILITY EASEMENT

The undersigned, SANDRA KAY NOBLET, her heirs, successors and assigns (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTOR"), for and in consideration of good and valuable consideration in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, convey and transfer to the CITY OF BURLINGTON (hereinafter referred to as the "CITY"), from the following property located in the County of Skagit, State of Washington:

That portion of Section 2, Township 34 North, Range 3 East, W.M., described as follows:

The West seven (7) acres of that portion of the Southwest ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 2, Township 34 North, Range 3 East, W.M., lying Northerly of the as built and existing County road running along the South line of said subdivision, as said road existed on December 18, 1969.

Subject to that portion, if any, lying within the right-of-way of Drainage District No.10, as condemned in Skagit County Superior Court Cause No. 8889, records of Skagit County, Washington.

A twenty (20) foot permanent easement lying five (5) feet Northwesterly and fifteen (15) feet Southeasterly of the following described line with a thirty (30) foot temporary construction easement lying five (5) feet Northwesterly and twenty-five (25) feet Southeasterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 2; thence South 20° 09' 22" West 3653.63 feet; thence South 35° 17' 03" West 110.80 feet; thence South 44° 43' 02" West 693.78 feet; thence South 10° 16' 31" East 32.00 feet; thence South 48° 43' 21" West 186.68 feet; thence South 38° 21' 12" West 332.39 feet; thence South 38° 50' 25" West 307.29 feet; thence South 52° 13' 38" West 215.20 feet; thence South 39° 50' 45" West 167.26 feet; thence South 6° 11' 46" East 454.68 feet to the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 2.

Said permanent easement including the perpetual right to enter upon the real estate hereafter described, at any time that the CITY may deem reasonably necessary to construct, maintain, repair and operate a sanitary sewer line, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches and trenches for the location of pipelines and mains, and the further right to remove trees, bushes, undergrowth and other obstructions interfering with the location, construction and maintenance of said pipelines and mains, and the further right of ingress to and egress from said described property for the foregoing purposes.

The CITY agrees to restore the area disturbed during installation of a sanitary sewer line by backfilling native or import material to 85% modified proctor test, to restore disturbed driveway areas with the materials similar to the existing materials, to restore disturbed pasture areas with top soil at a depth of four (4) inches and to hydroseed with pasture grass seed; provided the GRANTOR, its heirs or assigns shall restrict livestock from the above described permanent easement for a period of thirty (30) calendar days after the initial date of actual use of said permanent easement and, furthermore, shall not construct any permanent structure over, upon or within the permanent easement.


