TRUSTEE'S DEED

The GRANTOR, PROFESSIONAL FORECLOSURE CORPORATION OF WASHINGTON, as present Trustee under that Deed of Trust, as hereinafter particularly described, in consideration of the premises and payment, recited below, hereby grants and conveys without warranty, to Federal National Mortgage Association, Grantee, that real property, situated in the County of Skagit, State of Washington, described as follows:

THAT PORTION OF THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 35 NORTH, RANGE 9 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE COUNTY ROAD, 229 FEET EAST OF THE WEST LINE OF SAID SUBDIVISION, SAID POINT BEING THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THAT CERTAIN TRACT CONVEYED TO CHARLES STROUD AND GRACE STROUD, HUSBAND AND WIFE, BY DEED DATED MARCH 4, 1952 AND RECORDED MARCH 27, 1952, UNDER AUDITOR'S FILE NO. 473252, RECORDS OF SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON; THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID STROUD TRACT A DISTANCE OF 100 FEET; THENCE WEST PARALLEL WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID COUNTY ROAD A DISTANCE OF 229 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE WEST LINE OF SAID SUBDIVISION; THENCE NORTH ALONG SAID WEST LINE TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID COUNTY ROAD; THENCE EAST ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID COUNTY ROAD TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

RECITALS:

1. This Conveyance is made pursuant to the powers, including the power of sale, conferred upon said Trustee by that certain Deed of Trust between Timothy F. Bogart and Barbara A. Bogart husband and wife, as Grantor, to First American Title Insurance Company as Trustee, and Integra Pacific Mortgage, Inc., a Washington corporation, as Beneficiary, dated October 1, 1997, recorded October 7, 1997, as No. 9710070049, in Book/Reel None, Page/Frame None, records of Skagit County, Washington.

2. Said Deed of Trust was executed to secure, together with other undertakings, the payment of a promissory note(s) in the sum of \$74,100.00 with interest thereon, according to the terms thereof, in favor of Integra Pacific Mortgage, Inc., a Washington corporation, and to secure any other sums of money which might become due and payable under the terms of said Deed of Trust.
3. The described Deed of Trust provides that the real property conveyed therein is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes.
4. Default having occurred in the obligations secured and/or covenants of the Grantor as set forth in "Notice of Trustee's Sale" described below, which by the terms of the Deed of Trust made operative the power to sell, the thirty day advance "Notice of Default" was transmitted to the Grantor, or his successor in interest, and a copy of said Notice was posted or served in accordance with law.
5. Federal National Mortgage Association, being then the holder of the indebtedness secured by said Deed of Trust, delivered to said Trustee a written request directing said Trustee to sell the described property in accordance with law and the terms of said Deed of Trust.
6. The defaults specified in the "Notice of Default" not having been cured, the Trustee, in compliance with the terms of said Deed of Trust, executed and on July 14, 2000, recorded in the office of the Auditor of Skagit County, Washington, a "Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale of said property as Auditor's No. 200007140041. Notice of sale recorded on March 7, 2000 undr Auditor's No. 200003070133.
7. The Trustee, in its aforesaid "Notice of Trustee's Sale," fixed the place of sale as the main entrance to the Skagit County courthouse located in the City of Mount Vernon, a public place at 11:00 am, and in accordance with law, caused copies of the statutory "Notice of Trustee's Sale" to be transmitted by mail to all persons entitled thereto and either posted or served prior to ninety days before the sale; further, the Trustee caused a copy of said "Notice of Trustee's Sale" to be published once between the thirty-second and twenty-eighth day before the date of the sale and once between the eleventh and seventh day before the date of the sale in a legal newspaper in each county in which the property or any part thereof is situated; and further, included with this Notice, which was transmitted or served to or upon the Grantor or his successor in interest, a "Notice of Foreclosure" in substantially the statutory form, to which copies of the Grantor's Note and Deed of Trust were attached.
8. During the foreclosure, no action was pending on an obligation secured by said Deed of Trust.



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9. All legal requirements and all provisions of said Deed of Trust have been complied with, as to acts to be performed and notices to be given, as provided in Chapter 61.24 RCW.

10. The defaults specified in the "Notice of Trustee's Sale" not having been cured ten days prior to the date of Trustee's Sale and said obligation secured by said Deed of Trust remaining unpaid, on October 13, 2000, the date of sale, which was not less than 190 days from the date of default in the obligation



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
