**DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT**

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270 in regards to the drinking water source which is an alternative source other than a drilled well requiring filtration and disinfection treatment.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. This residence is served drinking water by a pre-existing, non-conforming, uncased dug well that has no surface seal and is 35 feet in depth. A Water Well Report was provided to Wash. State Dept. of Ecology May, 2001. The source requires properly maintained filtration and disinfection equipment for consistent and potable water. Filtration and disinfection are provided by the following system: two-30-micron-cartridge filters, one-5-micron-cartridge filter, an ultraviolet disinfection unit and a one-micron-cartridge filter. Poor water clarity (turbidity) may indicate that pathogens may be present at times in the drinking water. The turbidity result was 2 NTU. The drinking water standard is one NTU or less. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
  - a. conserving water use by installing low water use landscaping and fixtures,
  - b. having spare ultraviolet light bulbs, cartridge filters and maintaining a operation and maintenance log,
  - c. testing for turbidity during times of poor water clarity,
  - d. testing for bacteria on a quarterly basis and
  - e. providing appropriate maintenance to the filtration and disinfection units as directed by the manufacturer.
4. **Properites with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as justification for the creation of new lots and cannot be further subdivided.**
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health.
6. This water source is subject to the provisions of the Skagit County Seawater Intrusion Policy. The owner agrees to pump the source at 5 gpm or less with an elevated 300 gal. storage tank, test for chloride annually (September), and to record annual quantities of water used. Furthermore, it is recommended to conserve water and to measure the static water level annually (September).
