This indenture, made this 19 day of Leptinow, 2001, between ROBERT L. CHRISTENSEN and SARAH E. CHRISTENSEN, husband and wife, whose address is 9552 McGlinn Drive, La Conner, WA 98257, hereinafter referred to as the GRANTOR and SKAGIT COUNTY hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the GRANTOR is the owner of real property in Skagit, County: and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous of minimizing the storm drainage damage occurring in the vicinity of the GRANTOR'S property.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED that the COUNTY shall, in and for consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, have a perpetual and permanent right to enter and use a portion of land over and across the property of the GRANTOR the property is described in Exhibit A. The legal description of the land, as set forth in Exhibit A, is hereby incorporated by reference herein.

The COUNTY shall have the right of ingress and egress to enter upon the above-described lands to clean, construct, maintain, and operate a storm water collection system. All expense and costs for the construction, maintenance, and operation of said waterway shall be the responsibility of the COUNTY. The COUNTY may cut and remove from the said premises any trees and other obstructions that may endanger the safety of or interfere with the use of such facilities or appurtenances in the COUNTY easement. The COUNTY shall, upon completion of construction or maintenance on waterway, remove all debris and restore the surface of the property as nearly as possible to the condition immediately prior to the COUNTY'S entry to the property. The COUNTY has the right of ingress and egress to and over said premises at any and all times for the purpose of doing anything necessary, useful or convenient for the enjoyment of the easement hereby granted; and the right of conveyance of said easement and privileges.


