By this agreement made this 5 day of SEPTEMBER, 2001, THOMAS E. KAY and SHEILA MULLEN, husband and wife, (hereinafter referred to as "Owner") hereby grants permission to the COUNTY OF SKAGIT (hereinafter referred to as "County") and its assigns, the right and privilege to enter upon the land for the purpose of performing drainage improvement for the above listed project. Owner also hereby grants County the right to remove trees and vegetation and move other obstructions interfering with the construction and ground preparation, as is necessary to be performed in connection with subject project (see Exhibit "B", which is hereby incorporated by reference). The land to which this ingress and egress construction easement applies is set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", which is hereby incorporated by reference. The terms of this agreement shall be binding and shall be a covenant running with the land until the County has completed the above listed project, which shall not exceed 3 years.

The Owner and County, by granting and accepting this ingress and egress construction easement respectively, mutually covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The County and or its authorized agents or subcontractors will make reasonable efforts to minimize disruption and inconvenience to said property and uses made thereof.
- 2. This ingress and egress construction easement shall expire and become null and void at such time as the County has completed the drainage improvement project and all work associated therewith which time period will not exceed 3 years.
- 3. The County shall protect and save harmless the Owner from and against any and all claims, damage to or loss or destruction of property suffered by the Owner, his/her/their successors and assigns caused by said drainage improvement project, however, the County shall not be so obligated for any damage, loss or



destruction caused by the negligence of the Owner, his/her successors and assigns, tenants, licensees and invitees.

4. The County shall, upon completion of construction of said project described above, remove all debris and restore the surface of the property as nearly as possible to the condition immediately prior to the County's entry thereon excepting the modifications or improvements made as part of the drainage improvement project.

PARCEL NUMBERS P69160 AND P69161 THOMAS KAY AND SHEILA MULLEN

- Skagit County Public Works (S.C.P.W.) agrees to clear both Lots 1 and 2 of trees and brush, with the exception of a vegetative buffer along both lots' frontage on Snee-Oosh Road, at time of construction. S.C.P.W. agrees to remove all cleared debris from the property. The owners are responsible for tree stump removal, unless determined necessary by S.C.P.W. or its contractor.
- 2. Skagit County Public Works agrees to install fabric underlayment when constructing the access easement.
