lss ORDER VACATING COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY

COUNTY OF SKAGIT

In the matter of the request by Mr. Conrardy Stowe LLC.

For the vacation of unopened County right-of-way known as Central Avenue #10300.

In the matter of the vacation of a portion of County road right-of-way petitioned by Mr. Conrardy Stowe LLC, the Board finds as follows:

FIRST: That the request therefore was filed on the 31st day of January, 2002.

SECOND: That on the 6th day of May, 2002, the County Engineer was duly directed to examine said right-of-way and make a report in writing on the same.

THIRD: That on the 28th day of May, 2002, the County Engineer filed in the office of the Board his report on the proposed vacation in writing, as provided by law.

FOURTH: That by an order duly passed by this Board the 6th day of May, 2002, the 28th day of May, 2002 was set for hearing the report of the Engineer, and the consideration thereof, and that notice of the time and place where said hearing would be held as given by publication and posting as provided by law.

FIFTH: That said report of the County Engineer shows:

 This portion of Central Avenue is of no use for the existing county. road.

- The right-of-way is enclosed on three sides by property owners; its vacation will create more logical property boundaries.
- The right-of-way is of no benefit to the public as a County roadway and should be returned to the adjacent property owners.

the Board, having examined the report of the Engineer and all other papers on file in the proceedings, and heard and considered all testimony and documentary evidence produced for and against the vacation of the road, and the Board being satisfied that said right-of-way will not be useful as a part of a general road system, and that the public will be benefited by its vacation, did unanimously vote to vacate said road right-of-way described as follows:

Located in the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 19, Township 34 North, Range 2 East, W.M., the north 25 feet of the right-of-way of Central Avenue, (formerly Front Street), running from the center line of the vacated Fairview Avenue to the eastern line of the vacated Carlyle Avenue where it intersects with Deception Road, all abutting Blocks 211 and 212, "Plat of Fidalgo City", according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, Page 113, Records of Skagit County, Washington, signed the 7th of September, 1889. approximately 25 feet in width and 330 feet in length.

Situate in the County of Skagit, State of Washington. Less any Franchises or Easements of record.

Containing 0.20 acre.

An easement in gross is hereby reserved within the vacated right-of-way for all existing and future utilities, including extensions and improvements thereto, and recognition of any franchises of records.

It is Ordered by the Board, all the members concurring, that the County rightof-way requested to be vacated by Mr. Conrardy Stowe LLC, be vacated upon payment of all costs by the principal petitioner, if any; and the clerk of the Board is directed to make a statement in writing of all costs and expenses incurred in the same proceedings and file the same with the County Treasurer, who shall proceed to collect the same as follows below if directed to do so by the Board:
