STATE BOUNDARIES WERE POSTED WITH 5-FOOT LONG RED  
CARSONITE POSTS SET AT INTERVALS OF 220 FEET, ON  
AVERAGE.

THE ROAD COMING INTO GOVERNMENT LOT 4 FROM CAMP 2  
ROAD SERVES SEVERAL OWNERS. THE STATE'S DEED (AN  
971050011) DESCRIBES ITS OWNERSHIP AS CARRYING TO THE  
NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF THE COUNTY ROAD (SEE EXCEPTION  
FOR PROPERTY CONVEYED TO A.M. MORGAN). THE WIDTH OF THE  
ROAD IS NOT SPECIFIED IN THE DEEDS. THE ACREAGE SHOWN  
ON OUR DRAWING FOR THE STATE-OWNED PORTION OF  
GOVERNMENT LOT 4 INCLUDES THE 12 FOOT-WIDE DRIVING  
SURFACE OF THE ROAD. OTHERS MAY HAVE A LESS RIGHTS TO

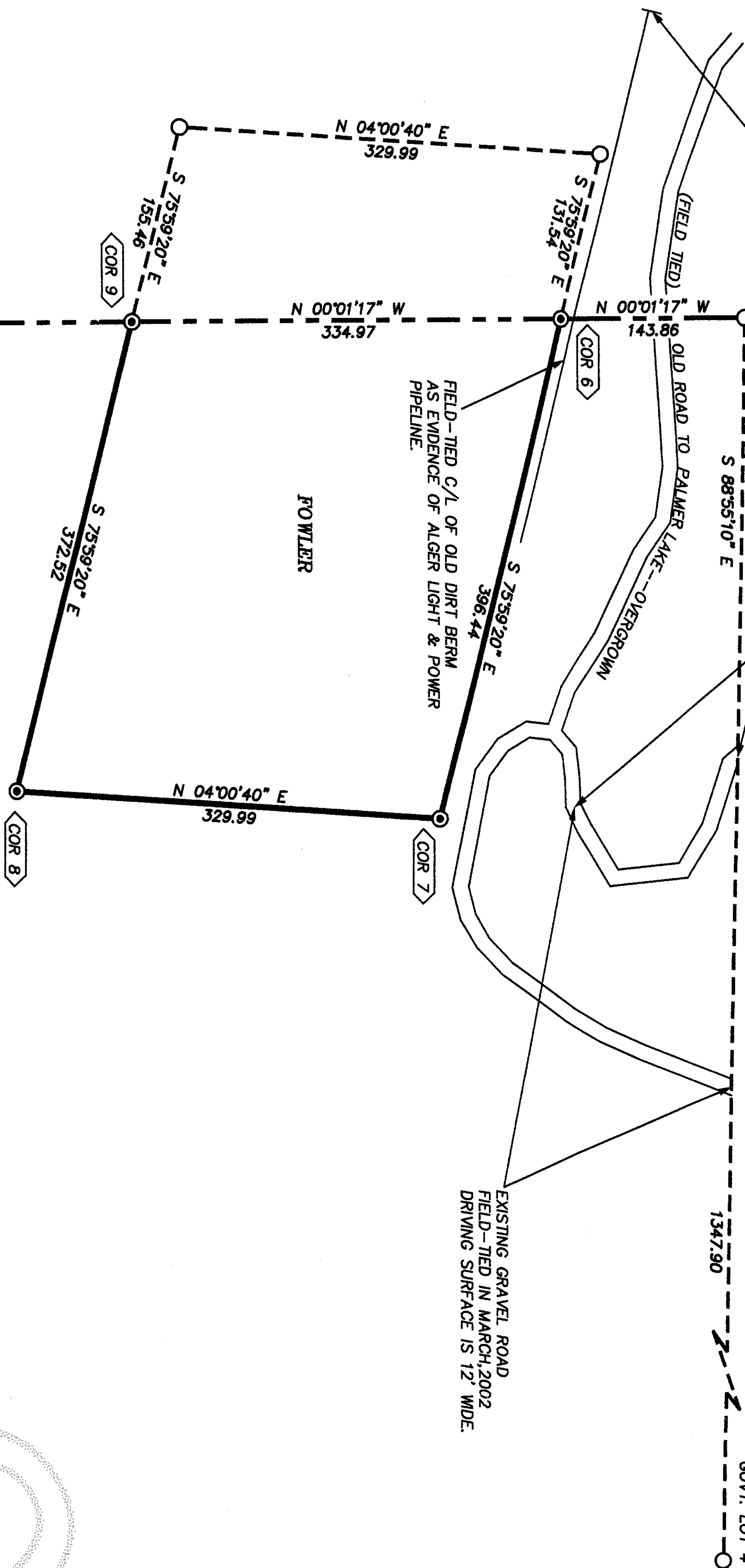

THE PRIVATE PARCEL IN THE SW 1/4 NW 1/4 OF SECTION 5 IS OWNED BY EMMETT AND DOROTHY FOWLER AND IS DESCRIBED IN THE DEED RECORDED UNDER AUDITOR'S FILE NUMBER 197045. THE DEED DESCRIBED UNDER THIS PARCEL CONTAINED AN AMBIGUITY. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO BEGIN AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5 AND WORK YOUR WAY THROUGH THE DESCRIPTION TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 4-ACRE PARCEL, AND BE 117 FEET FROM THE DAM. WE SUSPECT THAT THE STANDARD CORNER OF SECTIONS 5 & 6, THE DAM, BROKE DOWN BUT WITH REMAINS STILL IN EXISTENCE. WAS USEFUL IN CONTROLLING THE LOCATION OF THE 4-ACRE PARCEL. WE ALSO HELD EVIDENCE OF THE AS-BUILT ALGER LIGHT & WATER COMPANY PIPE LINE TO CONTROL THE ALIGNMENT OF THE NORTH LINE OF SAID 4-ACRE PARCEL.

ACCORDING TO A 1972 SURVEY IN SECTION 6 BY RADER, LEONARD & ASSOCIATES, IRON PIPES WERE SET ON THE LINE BETWEEN THE E 1/4 OF SECTION 6 AND THE CLOSING CORNER OF SECTIONS 6 & 5. WE DID NOT SEARCH FOR THESE DURING OUR SURVEY BUT WOULD EXPECT THEM TO BE WITHIN 2 FEET OF OUR LINE. THEY WOULD NOT LIKELY BE CLOSER THAN THAT DUE TO THE FACT THAT WE CALCULATED THE CLOSING CORNER OF SECTIONS 6 & 5 TO BE 2.15 FEET WEST OF THEIR LOCATION.

SHORT PLATS IN 1976 AND 1982 SET PROPERTY CORNERS ALONG THE WEST LINE OF GOVERNMENT LOT 3 AND THE EAST AND SOUTH LINES OF THE SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 5. WE DID NOT SEARCH FOR THESE AND A COMPARISON OF OUR MEASUREMENTS INDICATES THAT THE PROPERTY CORNER MARKERS OF RECORD SHOULD BE WITHIN 1 FOOT OF THE LINES SHOWN ON OUR MAP.

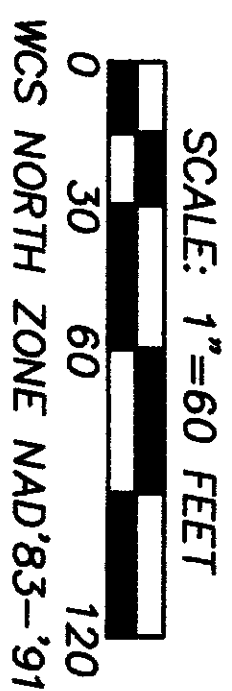

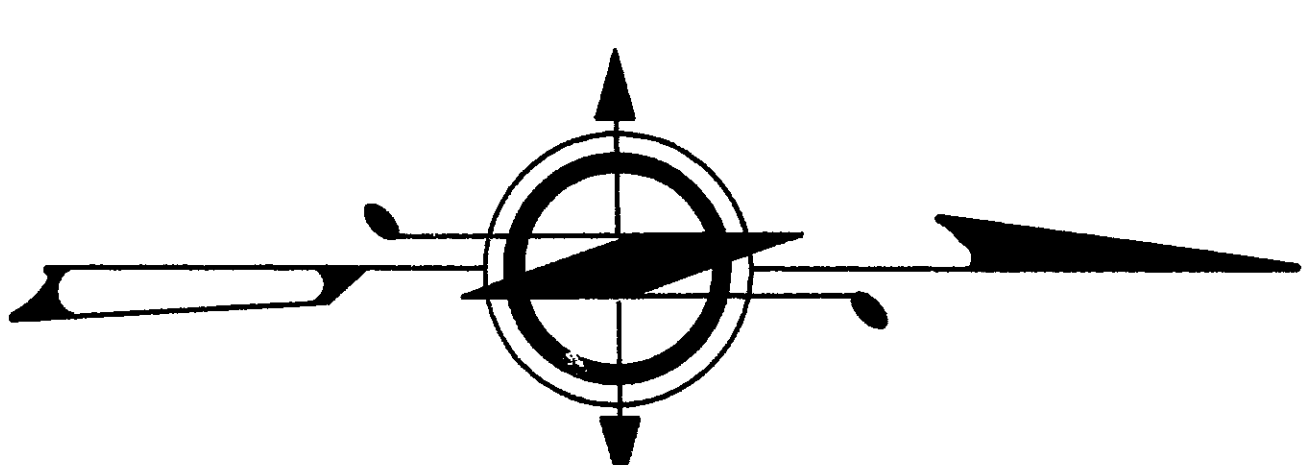
