The husband is awarded as his separate property the following property (list real estate, furniture, vehicles, pensions, insurance, bank accounts, etc.):

- (1) Husband's IRA which was valued at \$870 on March 31, 2000.
- (2) Husband's TSP retirement account held by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, which is valued at \$30,000.
- (3) Husband's Compushare Brokerage Account which is valued at \$506.50 on June 4, 2002.
- (4) \$3,000 of the \$8,000 balance in Whatcom Educational Credit Union Account No. 2\*\*7\*2 which Husband received on June 16, 2002.
- (5) The sum of \$9,364 as additional property settlement, which sum shall be paid by Wife to Husband within five (5) years of the date this Decree of Dissolution is entered, or at the time the residence located at 808 North Eighth Street, Mt. Vernon, Skagit County, Washington, is sold, if sold within five years of the date of entry of the Decree of Dissolution.

- (7) Husband's FERS basic benefit retirement plan from the Corps of Engineers which is valued at \$4,000.
- (8) Household furnishings, furniture, tools, and household goods currently in the possession of the Husband.

3.3 PROPERTY TO BE AWARDED TO THE WIFE.

The wife is awarded as her separate property the following property (list real estate, furniture, vehicles, pensions, insurance, bank accounts, etc.):

- (1) The balance in Whatcom Educational Credit Union Account 2\*\*7\*2 as of June 16, 2002.
- (2) Residence located at 808 North 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Mt. Vernon, Skagit County, Washington, and legally described as follows:  
Lot 4, Block 7, Pape's Addition to Mt. Vernon  
subject to the mortgage balance owing thereon.
- (3) Wife's IRA account which is valued at \$929 on March 31, 2002
- (4) Wife's 401K retirement account from employment with Haggen, Inc./Top Foods, which is valued at \$39,729 on June 12, 2002.
- (5) Wife's Compushare brokerage account, which was valued at \$182 on June 4, 2002.
- (6) Household furnishings, furniture, tools, and household goods currently in the Wife's possession.


