EASEMENT

THE GRANTOR, NRJR 2000 Limited Partnership I, a Washington limited partnership, for and in consideration of Granting of Easement rights and no other consideration, conveys to Vicki J. Wesen and Betty J. Smaby, each as her separate property, THE GRANTEES, and to their heirs, successors and assigns in ownership of the property described on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, a non-exclusive easement for ingress, egress and utilities over, under and across the following described tract:

The South 30 feet of the East 125 feet of the property described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Grantor and Grantees hereby enter in to the following agreements for the purpose of mutually maintaining said easement which services the properties described on Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto, as follows:

- 1. The owners of each property, and their heirs, successors and assigns, shall jointly and mutually maintain the easement described above so that it may continue to be used for joint ingress, egress and utilities.
- 2. The parties agree that each parcel owner shall be responsible for and shall pay on a 50/50 basis the cost for maintenance of the blacktop driveway located within the easement area.
- 3. The cost to repair any damage done to the blacktop driveway or right-of-way during construction shall be the sole responsibility of the parties causing such damage.

 This easement and maintenance agreement shall remain a permanent burden upon the respective parcels.


