On June 20, 2002 an illegal methamphetamine drug lab was confiscated by the Skagit County Interlocal Drug Task Force, Anacortes Police Department, and Snohomish Drug Task Force while executing a search warrant at the above address. Due to the chemical processes involved in the manufacture of methamphetamine and the chemicals and equipment removed from the scene contamination presents a potential immediate or long-term health hazard. The property at the above address was therefore designated unfit for use as of June 24, 2002.


During September and October of 2002 you removed the contents of the house, and the garbage in back of the house. On October 19, 2002 the Anacortes Fire Department coordinated a Live Fire Training Burn on the house. The remaining debris from the burn was removed by November 8,

2002. Septic tanks were pumped on October 28. I have reviewed your documentation of these activities and inspected the site. This site is now completely vacant. The solid waste from the project has been removed to a permitted landfill. There are no other issues relating to the drug lab remaining on the property.

The information upon which the property was originally declared unfit for use has been addressed by the above removal of all structures and solid waste from the property. The Skagit County Health Department has released this property for use.
