This property is served by a 2-connection water system that is subject to the requirements stated in Group B Water Systems Chapter 246-291 WAC. This system may also be subject to other state and local regulations and approval letters from SCHD. The system owner is responsible for maintaining system compliance. The name of the water system at the time of approval was **Challenger Ridge Winery Water System**.

The water system was designed and approved for services at parcel numbers 43509 and 43510. Additional planning and design approvals must be obtained from the SCHD prior to expanding beyond this number of services or whenever changes are made to the water system.

Please note that the design standards for this system should be limited to only the necessary functions of the project. Activities outside the intended use may require additional review by the SCHD. Additionally, if system wide water use exceeds 5,000 gallons per day or if the total property being irrigated by the system exceeds 1/2 acre, a water right permit must be obtained from the Department of Ecology.

The on-going requirements for maintaining this water system include the following:

- Perform a coliform bacteria test at least once every 12 months and submit the results to our department.
- Perform a nitrate test at least once every 30 months and submit the results to our department.
- Follow the well setback requirements.
- Maintain the water system in a secure and sanitary manner.
- Update the Water Facility Inventory Form as the information changes.

Prior to purchasing this property, it is recommended that you contact the department to determine whether this system is in compliance with applicable regulations. Fees may be charged by the department for providing information in this public water system and other various services.

The SCHD maintains current information on the system to expedite retrieval of information for your use or for lending institutions that require information on the system as part of their approval process.

As allowed by WAC 246-291-030 the SCHD reduced certain requirements for the approval of this water system. An engineer was not required to design the water system.
