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OPEN SPACE TAXATION AGREEMENT

Chapter 84.34 RCW

(To be used for "Open Space", "Timber Land" Classification or "Reclassification" Only)

This agreement between John Klein

hereinafter called the "Owner", and SKAGIT COUNTY

hereinafter called the "Granting Authority".

Whereas the owner of the above described real property having made application for classification of that property under the provisions of Chapter 84.34 RCW.

And whereas, both the owner and granting authority agree to limit the use of said property, recognizing that such land has substantial public value as open space and that the preservation of such land constitutes an important physical, social, esthetic, and economic asset to the public, and both parties agree that the classification of the property during the life of this agreement shall be for:

Now, therefore, the parties, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth herein, do agree as follows:

1. During the term of this agreement, the land shall be used only in accordance with the preservation of its classified use.
2. No structures shall be erected upon such land except those directly related to, and compatible with, the classified use of the land.
3. This agreement shall be effective commencing on the date the legislative body receives the signed agreement from the property owner and shall remain in effect until the property is withdrawn or removed from classification.
4. This agreement shall apply to the parcels of land described herein and shall be binding upon the heirs, successors and assignees of the parties hereto.
5. **Withdrawal:** The landowner may withdraw from this agreement if, after a period of eight years, he or she files a request to withdraw classification with the assessor. Two years from the date of that request the assessor shall withdraw classification from the land, and the applicable taxes and interest shall be imposed as provided in RCW 84.34.070 and 84.34.108.
6. **Breach:** After the effective date of this agreement, any change in use of the land, except through compliance with items (5), (7), or (9), shall be considered a breach of this agreement, and shall be subject to removal of classification and liable for applicable taxes, penalties, and interest as provided in RCW 84.34.080 and RCW 84.34.108.

7. A breach of agreement shall not have occurred and the additional tax shall not be imposed if removal of classification resulted solely from:
- a) Transfer to a governmental entity in exchange for other land located within the State of Washington.
 - b) A taking through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power in anticipation of the exercise of such power and having manifested its intent in writing or by other official action.
 - c) A natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other such calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the land owner changing the use of such property.
 - d) Official action by an agency of the State of Washington or by the county or city where the land is located disallowing the present use of such land.
 - e) Transfer of land to a church when such land would qualify for exemption pursuant to RCW 84.36.020.
 - f) Acquisition of property interests by State agencies or agencies or organizations qualified under RCW 84.34.210 and 64.04.130 (See RCW 84.34108(5)(f)).
 - g) Removal of land classified as farm and agricultural land under RCW 84.34.020(2)(d).
 - h) Removal of land from classification after enactment of a statutory exemption that qualifies the land for exemption and receipt of notice from the owner to remove the land from classification.
 - i) The creation, sale, or transfer of forestry riparian easements under RCW 76.13.120.
 - j) The creation, sale, or transfer of a fee interest or a conservation easement for the riparian open space program under RCW 76.09.040.
8. The county assessor may require an owner to submit data relevant to continuing the eligibility of any parcel of land described in this agreement.
9. Reclassification as provided in Chapter 84.34 RCW.

This agreement shall be subject to the following conditions:

It is declared that this agreement specifies the classification and conditions as provided for in Chapter 84.34 RCW and the conditions imposed by this Granting Authority. This agreement to tax according to the use of the property is not a contract and can be annulled or canceled at any time by the Legislature (RCW 84.34.070).

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EXHIBIT "A"

PARCEL A:

The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 35 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian;

EXCEPT that portion lying Easterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter;
thence North $88^{\circ}12'47''$ West a distance of 24.0 feet to the point of beginning of said line;
thence South $01^{\circ}19'35''$ West a distance of 1,321.79 feet, more or less, to the South line of said subdivision, at a point bearing North $88^{\circ}55'52''$ West and 46.0 feet distant from the Southeast corner of said subdivision and being the terminus of said line.

PARCEL B:

The West 20 feet of that portion of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 35 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying South of the as built and existing Utopia County Road;

ALSO beginning at a point on the South line of the Utopia County Road 20 feet East of the West line of said East Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 14;
thence East along the South line of said county road a distance of 55 feet;
thence Southwesterly a distance of 65 feet, more or less, to a point on the East line of above described 20 foot strip a distance of 35 feet South of the point of beginning;
thence North to the point of beginning.

PARCEL C:

That portion of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 35 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying South of the as built and existing Utopia County Road.
