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SIXTH: That said report of the County Engineer shows:

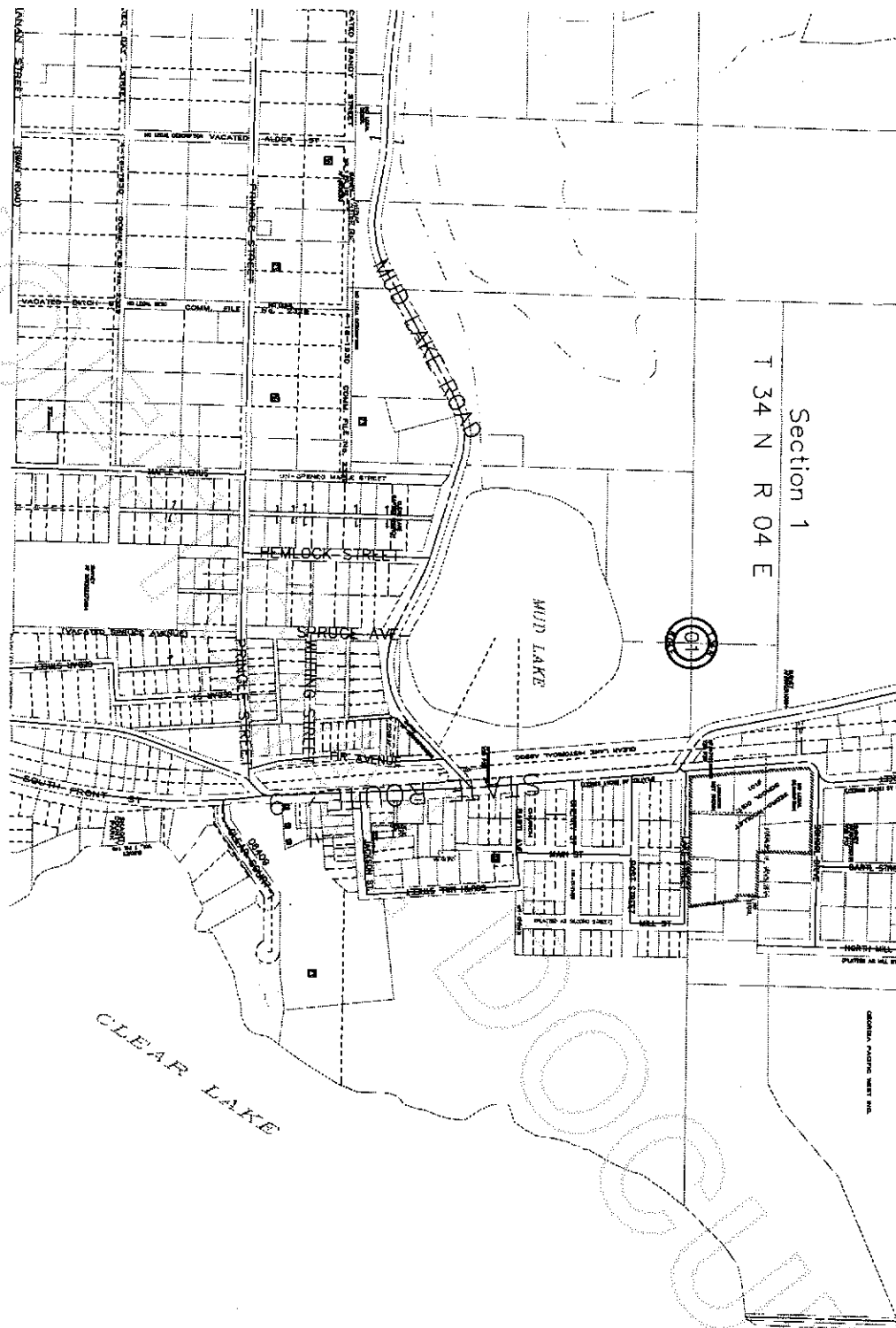
