DUVALL, husband and wife for and in consideration of TEN DOLLARS AND OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION in hand paid, conveys and warrants to Brandon Dills, a married man as his separate estate the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skagit, State of Washington.

That portion of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 18, Township 36 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as follows:

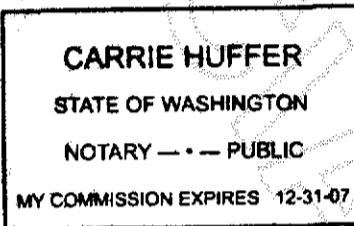

D. Reservation contained in deed through which title is claimed from Ernest W. Duvall and Louise Duvall, husband and wife, recorded March 24, 1957, under Auditor's File No. 696502, as follows:

"AND RESERVING to the grantors, their successors and assigns an easement for the benefit of property owned by the grantors comprising a tract of approximately 7 acres lying Northerly of the property herein granted, said easement to be for roadway purposes and for the purpose on constructing, installing and maintaining utility pipes and lines and for general roadway purposes and reserving also to the grantors, their successors and assigns, for the benefit of the property owned by the grantors lying Northerly of the property granted, the right to withdraw water from a spring located on the granted premises.
