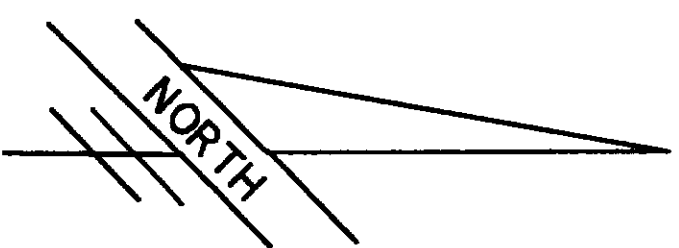

LAKE CAVANAUGH

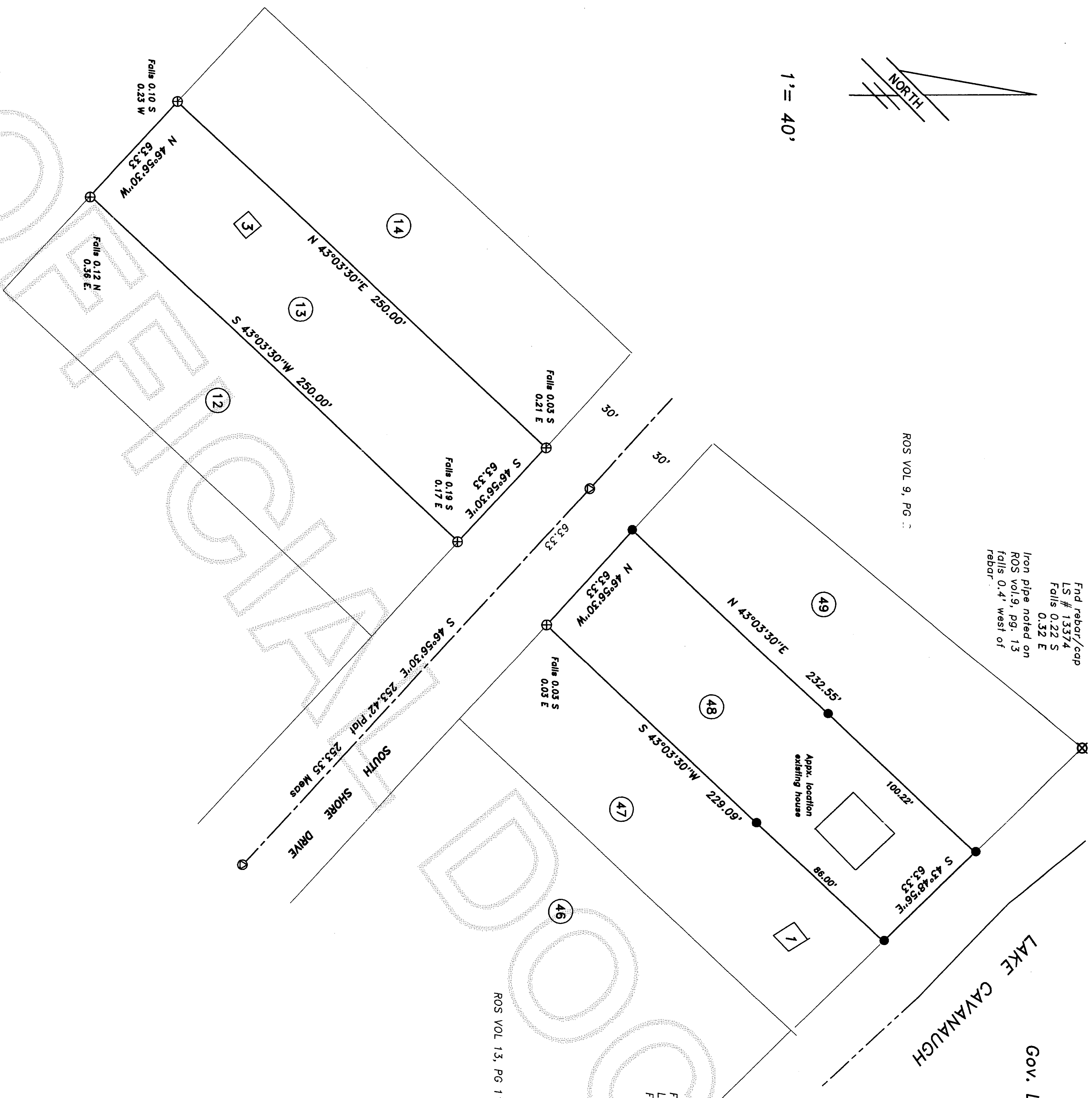
