

An easement is hereby reserved for and granted to the City of Burlington; Public Utility District No. 1; Puget Power; G.T.E.; Cascade Natural Gas Corp. and TCI Cablevision of Washington, Inc., and their respective successors and assigns under and upon the exterior \_\_\_\_\_ feet parallel and adjacent to the street frontage of all lots in which to install, lay, construct, renew, operate and maintain underground conduits, cable and wires with necessary facilities and other equipment for the purpose of serving the subdivision and other property with electric, television and telephone service, TOGETHER WITH the right to enter upon the lots at all times for the purposes stated.

- 2. Right of the public to make necessary slopes for cuts or fills upon said premises in the reasonable original grading of streets, avenues, alleys and roads.
- 3. Buyers should be aware that this plat is located in the flood plain of the Skagit River and significant elevation may be required for the first living floor of residential construction.
- 4. Tracts "A" and "B" represent area outside of road right-of-way and are to be boundary line adjusted to adjoining properties. Said Tracts do no represent building lots.
- 5. No fence shall be constructed across the access road or in the detention/retention pond areas.
- 6. Mowing and maintenance of the drainage easement areas shall be the responsibility of the individual lot owners
- 7. A Utilities Easement affecting the North 10 feet of Lots 3 through 5, and the West 10 feet o Lots 15 and 16.
