In consideration of U.S Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit 18, Reference No. 2001-4-01337, and the condition established therein requiring the recording of a native growth protection area (NGPA) easement for wetland areas (post-development and mitigation) on the Chuckanut Crest Golf Course property, and mutual benefits herein, Grantor, the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, the owner in fee of that certain real property described in Exhibit "B", attached hereto, does hereby establish a non-exclusive,

perpetual NGPA easement over, along and across certain portions of the above described property. Said portions are denoted as post-development wetlands delineated by ATSI (1992 and 2001), Wetland Mitigation Area "A", Wetland Restoration Area "A", Wetland Restoration Area "B", Wetland Restoration Area "C", and Wetland Restoration Area "D" on the maps attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (sheets 1-4). Grantor does hereby grant, convey and warrant to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, a part of the executive branch of the federal government of the Unites States, the right of ingress and egress to and from this easement for the purpose of monitoring and enforcing proper operation and maintenance of the NPGA easement described herein.

This NGPA easement is granted subject to and conditioned upon the following terms, conditions and covenants:

1. The legal description of the NGPA easement area is as established in Exhibit "A".

2. The NGPA easement areas need not be placed in separate tracts, or surveyed by a

licensed surveyor.

3. Grantor is hereby required to leave NGPA easement areas undisturbed in a natural state with the following exceptions: mitigation, restoration or enhancement activities are permitted; and vegetation management (not including the filling of wetlands or the waters of the United States) is permitted subject to approval by Skagit County.


4. Except as permitted under (3) above, no clearing, grading, filling, logging or removal of woody material, building, construction or road construction of any kind, or planting of non-native vegetation is allowed within the NGPA easement area except as specifically permitted in writing by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

5. Grantor retains the right to use and possess the real property over which the easement is granted consistent with permits approved by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Grantor agrees not to interfere with or obstruct the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers use of the assement

Engineers use of the easement.

6. Should any human disturbance of the NGPA that is inconsistent with the terms of this NGPA easement be caused or be allowed to be caused by the Grantor at any time, it shall be the responsibility of the Grantor to restore and return the affected area to its pre-disturbance condition.

7. The parties recognize that this NGPA easement is created, granted and accepted for the benefits of the inherent natural functions provided by the NGPA, but shall not be construed to provide open or common space for members of the public. By acceptance of this easement for purposes described, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers does not accept or assume any liability for acts or omissions of the Grantor, the fee simple owners, his or her invitees, licensees, or other third parties within the easement area. Grantor holds the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers harmless from any damage or injury to any property or person by any person entering the easement area not expressly authorized to do so by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.



- 8. Grantor agrees that this easement shall run with the land and that the rights and obligations of Grantor and Grantee shall inure to the benefit of each and shall be binding upon their respective heirs, successors and assigns.
- 9. Grantor, the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, covenants that it owns the property described herein and has the lawful right to convey the interest in the property to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the benefit of the public forever.
