Re: Plat of Channel View lot 12 individual well water supply

Our department was contacted by Mark Antoncich, the contact person for the Channel View Water Association, regarding the water supply for lot 12 (parcel # 117204) of the Channel View Plat. The purpose of this letter is to clarify the intent of the water supply notes for the Plat of Channel View and state how our department will interpret them for building permit purposes (water supply approval) for lot 12.

The Channel View Plat water supply notes are contradictory. The notes first state: "One well will be drilled on lot 12 for water service only to that lot". Then later in the notes the following statement is made: "This plat is located in a sea water intrusion area and therefore no person shall drill or construct a well within this plat".

The intent of the water supply notes is to ensure that no water wells are drilled within the Channel View Plat except for the individual well that needs to be drilled on lot 12 for water service only to that lot.

The water supply for the Channel View Water Association public water system consists of 3 wells on lots 1, 2, and 3 of short plat 95-037. This public water system is approved to one residence each on lots 1-11 of the Channel View Plat and lot 1 of short plat 95-034.

Our department reviews and approves individual wells for building permits as well as interprets plat water notes for adequacy. We actually approved these specific plat water notes and did not catch this inconsistency. Our department will accept a well drilled on lot 12 for a single residential building on that lot (as long a water quality/quantity is adequate and the well is legally drilled and appropriately located).

Because lot 12 is within a sea water intrusion area the "Interim Seawater Intrusion Policy" must be followed. Our department must be contacted by the property owner and/or well driller prior to drilling the well and we may make requirements as to the location of the well.
