RECITALS:

- 1. This Conveyance is made pursuant to the powers, including the power of sale, conferred upon said Trustee by that certain Deed of Trust between MOUNT BAKER EVERGREEN, INC., as GRANTOR, to LAND TITLE COMPANY as TRUSTEE, and SKAGIT STATE BANK as BENEFICIARY, dated September 5, 2000, recorded September 6, 2000, as Auditor's No. 200009060108, records of Skagit County, Washington,
- 2. Said Deed of Trust was executed to secure, together with other undertakings, the payment of one (1) Promissory Note in the sum of THREE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIVE AND 67/100 DOLLARS (\$305,505.67) with interest thereon, according to the terms thereof, in favor of SKAGIT STATE BANK, as noted in Paragraph 1 above and to secure any other sums of money which might become due and payable under the terms of said Deed of Trust.
- 3. The said Deed of Trust provides that the real property conveyed therein is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes.
