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DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270 in regards to the drinking water source which is an alternative source other than a drilled well requiring disinfection treatment.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. The drinking water for this residential building is served by a 28' dug well that meets the State Dept. of Ecology minimum standards (WAC 173-160) for a dug well. This source requires continuous filtration and disinfection to be consistently sanitary. To accomplish this task, they installed a 40-micron-automatic backwashing filter, a Sterilight SQ8 Ultraviolet unit and 5-micron-filter under the house. Poor water clarity (turbidity) may indicate that pathogens may be present at times in the drinking water. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
 - a. having spare ultraviolet lights and filters,
 - b. maintaining an operation and maintenance log,
 - c. testing for turbidity during times of poor water clarity,
 - d. testing for bacteria on a quarterly basis and
 - e. providing appropriate maintenance to the filtration and ultraviolet units as directed by the manufacturer.
4. **Properties with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as justification for the creation of new lots and can not be further subdivided. Land subdivisions require either drilled wells or connections to an approved public system.**
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health or at the Skagit County Permit Center in the water files.
