- A. CLASSIFICATION UNDER CHAPTER \$6.34 RCW. Uwe request that this land retain the current use classification as . Open Space Land, . Farm and Agricultural Land, . Timberland, and I am/we are aware of the following land use classifications;
  - 1. OPEN SPACE LAND MEANS EITHER:
    - a. any land area so designated by an official comprehensive land use plan adopted by any city or
    - b. any land area, the preservation of which in its present use would: (i) conserve and enhance natural or acmic resources; (ii) protect streams or water supply; (iii) promote conservation of soils, wetland, beaches, or tidal merahes; (iv) enhance the value to the public of abuning or neighboring parks, forests, wildlife preserves, nature reservations or sanctuaries or other open space; (v) enhance researched opportunities; (vi) preserve bistoric stree; (vii) preserve visual quality along highway, read, and street considers or seemic vistas; or (viii) retain in its natural state tracts of land not less than one area situated in an urban area and open to public use on such conditions as may be reasonably required by the legislative body granting the open space classification; or
    - conservation land is either; (i) land that was previously classified as open space farm and agricultural agricultural land that no longer meets the criteria of farm and agricultural land, and that is reclassified as open space and under RCW 84.34.020(1); or (ii) land that is traditional farmland that is not classified under chapter 84.33 or 84.34 RCW, that has not been irrevocably devoted to a use inconstatent with agricultural uses, and that has a high potential for returning to commercial agriculture.

## 2. FARM AND AGRICULTURAL LAND MEANS EITHER:

- a. sny parcel of land or configuous parcels of land in the same ownership of twenty or more acres: (i) devoted primarily to the production of livestock or agricultural commodities, for commercial purposes; or (ii) smolled in the federal conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of agriculture; or (iii) other similar commercial activities as may be established by rule; or
- b. any percel of land or contiguous parcels of land in the same ownership of at least five acres but less than twenty sorts devoted primarily to agricultural uses which has produced a gross income equal to two hundred dollars or more per sore per year for three out of the five calendar years preceding the date of application for classification under chapter 84.34 RCW; or
- c. smy percel of land that is isses then five scree devoted primarily to agricultural uses which has produced a gruss income squal to fifteen hundred dollars or more per year for three out of the five calcular years preceding the date of application for classification under chapter 84.34 RCW; or
- d. any land on which the principal place of residence of the farm operator or owner of land or housing for employees is sized if the farm and agricultural land is classified pursuant to RCW 84.34.020 (c) if the residence or housing is on or contiguous to the classified pursuant to RCW 84.34.020 (c) if housing is integral to the use of the classified land for agricultural purposes.

Agricultural land also includes (i) land on which appurtenences necessary for the production, preparation, or sale of commercial agricultural products are situated when the appurtenences are used in conjunction with the land(s) producing agricultural products, (ii) land incidentally used for an activity or enterprise that is comparible with commercial agricultural purposes as long as the incidental use does not exceed twenty percent of the classified land, and (iii) any noncontiguous percels of land from one to five series in size that constitutes an integral part of the commercial agricultural operations of a classified parcel of farm and agricultural land.

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3. TIMBER LAND MEANS any percel or contiguous percels of land in the same ownership of five or more acres devoted primarily to the growing and harvesting of forest crops for commercial purposes. Timber land means the land only.

I've declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of withdrawal or removal of this land from classification to the following extent:

- If the owner has filed the proper notice of request to withdraw the classified land and the land has been classified for a minimum of ten years he/she shall pay an amount equal to the difference. between the tax computed on the basis of "current use" and the tax computed on the basis of true and fair value plus interest at the same standory rate charged on delinquent property taxes. The additional tax and interest shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- If land is removed from classification because of a change to a non-conforming use, land is removed prior to the minimum ten year period, or land is removed because the owner(s) failed to comply with the two year notice of withdrawal he/she shall be liable to pay the additional tax and interest described in I above plus a penalty of twenty percent of the additional tax and interest. The additional tax, interest, and penalty shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- The additional tex, interest, and/or penalty shall not be imposed if the withdrawal or removal from classification resulted solely from:
  - transfer to a government entity in exchange for other land located within the state of Washington:
  - b. a taking through the exercise of the power of emment domain, or sale or transfer to an entity baving the power of eminest domain in anticipation of the exercise of this power, said sotiry having manifested its intent in writing or by other official action;
  - c. a natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other calamity rather than by virtue of the act of the landowner changing the use of the classified land;
  - d. official action by an agency of the state of Washington or by the county or city within which the land is located that disallows the present classified use of the land;
  - transfer of land to a church when the land would qualify for examption pursuant to RCW 84.36.020;
  - £ acquisition of property interests by a state or federal agency, county, city, town, metropolitan park district; metropolitan municipal corporation, nonprofit historic preservation corporation as defined in RCW 64.04.130, or nonprofit nature conservancy corporation or association as defined mRCW 84.34.250;
  - g. removal of classified farm and agricultural land on which the principal residence of the farm operator or owner or housing for employees;
  - h. removal of land from classification after enactment of a statutory exemption that qualifies the land for exemption and receipt of notice from the owner to remove the land from classification;
  - the creation, sale, or transfer of forestry riparian excements under RCW 76.13.120;
  - the creation, sale, or transfer of a fee interest or a conservation easement for the riperian open space program under RCW 76.09,040;
  - k. the sale or transfer of land within two years after the death of the owner of at least a fifty percent interest in the land if the land has been assessed and valued as designated forest land under chapter 84.33 RCW, or classified under this chapter 84.34 continuously since 1993;
  - l. the sale or transfer of land after the death of the owner of at least a fifty percent interest in the land if the land has been assessed and valued as designated forest land under chapter 84.33 RCW, or classified under this chapter 84.34 RCW continuously since 1993 and the sale or transfer takes place within two years after July 22, 2001, and the death of the owner occurred after January 1, 1991; or
  - m, the date of death shown on a death contificate is the date used.

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B. CLASSIFICATION UNDER CHAPTER 84.53 RCW. I/we request that this land retains its designation as forest land and I am/we are aware of the following definition of forest land. FOREST LAND is synonymous with designated forest land and means all contiguous land in the same ownership of at least twenty acres that is primarily devoted to and used for growing and harvesting timber

I/we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of removal of this land from designated forest land and upon removal a compensating tax shall be impossed that shall be equal to the difference between the amount of tax last levied on the land as forest land and an amount equal to the now assessed valuation of the land multiplied by the dollar rate of the last lavy extended against the land, multiplied by a number, not greater than ulus, equal to the number of years the land was designated as forest land.

The compensating tex shall not be imposed if the removal of designation resulted solely from:

- a. transfer to a government outity in exchange for other forest land located within the state of Washington;
- b. a raining through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or sale or transfer to an entity having the power of eminent domain in apticipation of the exercise of this power;
- C. a donation of fee title, development rights, or the right to harvest timber, to a government agency of organization qualified under HCW 84.34.210 and 64.04.130 for the purposes sugmented in those sections or the sale or transfer of fee title to a governmental entity or a nonprofit nature conservancy corporation, as defined in RCW 64.04.130 exclusively for the protection and conservation of lands recommended for state natural area preserve purposes by the natural heritage council and natural heritage plan as defined in chapter 79.70 RCW. At such time as the land is not used for the purposes emmastated, the compensating tax specified in subsection (11) of this section shall be imposed upon the current owner;
- d. the sale or transfer of fee title to the paries and recreation commission for park and recreation purposes;
- e. official action by an agency of the state of Washington or by the country or city within which the land is located that disallows the present use of such land;
- f. the creation, sale, or transfer of forestry riparian casements under RCW 76.13.120;
- g. the creation, exic, or transfer of a fee interest or a conservation easement for the riparism open space program under RCW 76.09.040;
- h. the sale or transfer of land within two years after the death of the owner of at least a fifty percent interest in the land if the land has been assessed and valued as designated forest land under chapter \$4.33 RCW, or classified under chapter \$4.34 continuously since 1993;
- the sale or transfer of land after the death of the owner of at least a fifty percent interest in the land if the land has been assessed and valued as designated forest land under chapter 84.33 RCW, or classified under chapter 84.34 RCW continuously since 1993 and the sale or transfer takes place within two years after July 22, 2001, and the death of the owner occurred after January 1, 1991; or

j. the date of death shown on the death certificate is the date used.
