**FINAL ORDER TO VACATE**

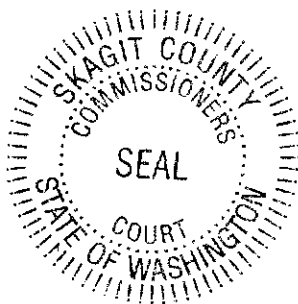
The Board, having on the 13th day of February, 2006, ordered the vacation of said right-of-way upon payment by the principal petitioner of all costs and expenses incurred in the proceedings as directed by the Board and said costs and expenses, if any, amounting to the sum of \$100.00 having been paid to the Treasure of this County:

It is ordered by the Board, all the members concurring, that the County right-of-way requested to be vacated by Mr. Clay Learned, be vacated described as follows:

Located in the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter of Section 9, Township 35 North, Range 8 East, W.M., unopened county right-of-way known as Pacific Street, south of State Route 20 and west of Concrete Sauk Valley Road, approximately 1315 feet in length and 20 feet in width. That portion of C.W. Griest's Plat of Grasmere filed in Vol. 3 of Plats at page 94, records of Skagit County, Washington, signed March 8, 1911.

An easement in gross is hereby reserved within the vacated right-of-way for all existing and future utilities, including extensions and improvements thereto, and recognition of any franchises of records.

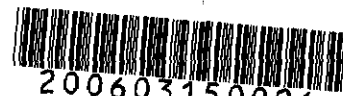
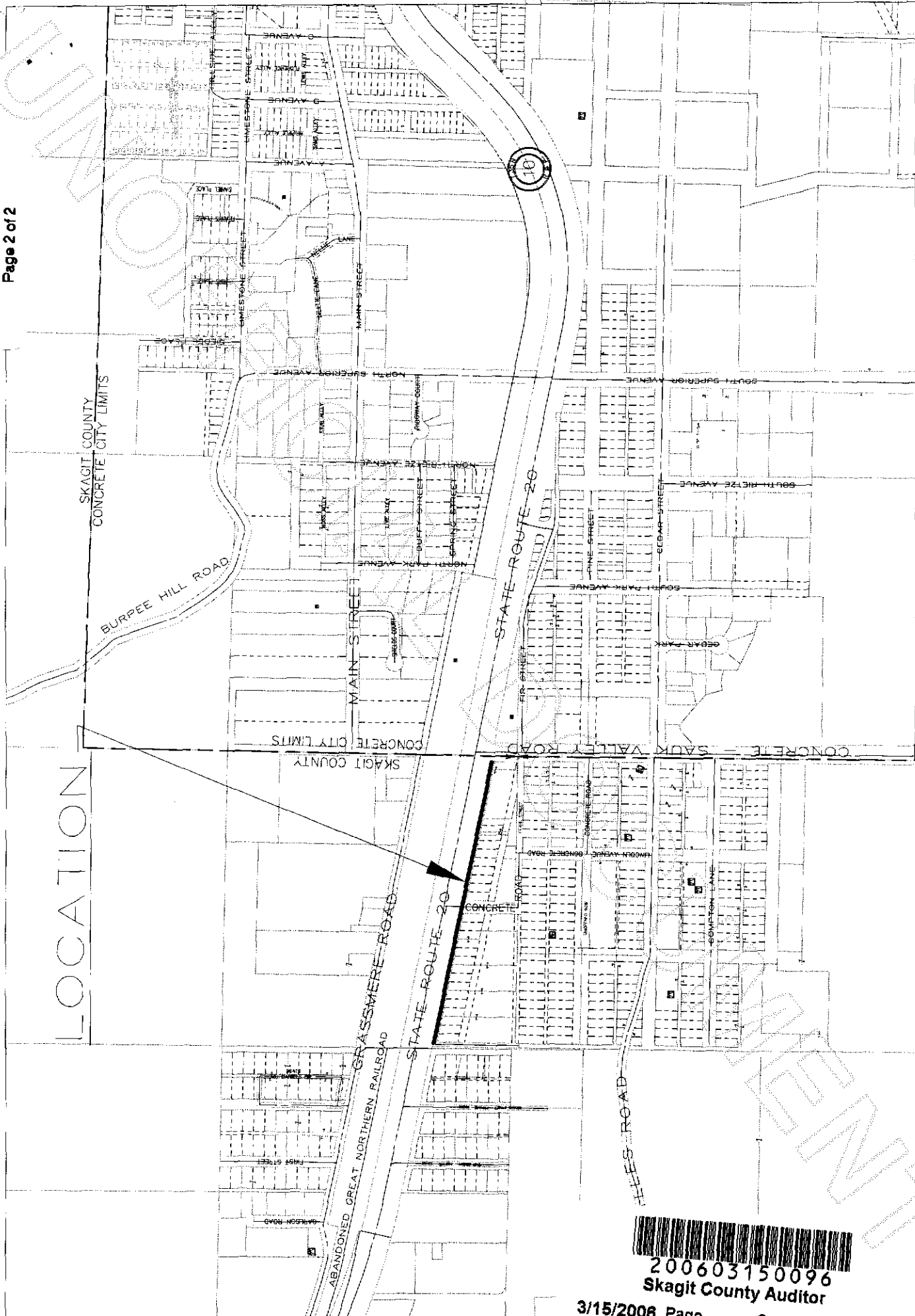
