**DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT**

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270 in regards to the drinking water source which is an alternative source other than a drilled well requiring filtration and disinfection treatment.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. The drinking water for this single family residence is served by a dug well that required a State Dept. of Ecology variance for a substandard surface seal of 8 feet instead of 18 feet. The variance from WAC 173-160 was granted September 12, 2005. This alternative source requires filtration and disinfection to be consistently sanitary. Filtration and disinfection are provided by the following method: 25 micron bag filter, chlorination, 500 gallon tank, 20 micron canister, and water softener system followed by a .5 micron briquette filter prior to drinking. Poor water clarity (turbidity) may indicate that pathogens may be present at times in the drinking water. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
  - a. monitoring water use and conserving water when necessary,
  - b. having spare system components,
  - c. maintaining an operation and maintenance log,
  - d. testing for turbidity during times of poor water clarity,
  - e. testing for bacteria in the drinking water on a quarterly basis and
  - f. following the manufacturer's recommendations for all the components.
4. **Properites with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as justification for the creation of new lots and can not be further subdivided.**
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health.
