(3) I/we understand that applications/notifications are subject to the
reforestation requirements as described in RCW 76.09 and WAC Title 222, the
Forest Practices rules. I/we also understand that the reforestation requirements
shall not apply only if the land is, in fact, converted unless applicable alternatives
or limitations are provided in Forest Practices rules issued under RCW
76.09.070. I/we further understand that it is the obligation of the forest land owner
or the owner of perpetual rights to cut timber owned separately from the land to
ensure that such reforestation takes place. I/we understand that the obligation to
reforest shall become the obligation of the new owner if the land or perpetual
timber rights are sold or otherwise transferred.
(4) I/we understand that if I/we have declared that the land subject to

this forest practices application/notification will not be converted to an active use incompatible with timber growing, that the land shall be subject to a six-year moratorium which will preclude current and/or successor forest land owners from obtaining development permits while the moratorium is in place. The moratorium shall begin on the approval date of the forest practices application/notification. I/we understand that this means that the county, city, town and/or regional governmental entities shall deny any or all applications for permits or approvals, including but not limited to building permits and subdivision approvals, relating to nonforestry uses of the land subject to the application/notification. The local governmental entity may lift the six-year moratorium if it so chooses through a process, which shall include public notification, and procedures for appeals and public hearings.

(5) I/we understand that the six-year moratorium shall be imposed for applications/notifications, which include a Conversion Option Harvest Plan approved by the local governmental entity if the forest practices are not conducted in compliance with the approved forest practices permit.
