

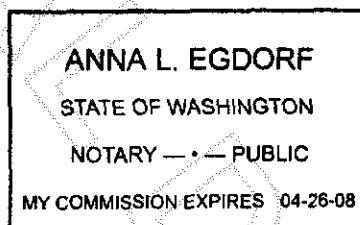

### Legal description
