

Conditional Waiver of Restrictive Covenant for Skagit Valley Organics Water System

The Skagit County Public Health Department issues a waiver to the requirement for Restrictive Covenant for the portion of the 100 foot sanitary control area of the well serving the Skagit Valley Organics Water System located on parcels P41664 and P40790 provided the following conditions exist:

- The owner of these parcels refuses to sign a restrictive covenant for wellhead protection
- The land use on the parcels remains as open space without any threats to the well in the form of
 - o Chemical use on the land
 - o Building construction
 - o Vehicle storage
 - o Septic system placement
 - O Any other activities that could threaten the water quality or safety of the well

Should land use changes occur within the 100 foot wellhead protection area the Skagit Valley Organics water system manager must immediately notify the Skagit County Public Health Department. The Skagit County Public Health Department may takes steps at that time to require increased protection of the well or require a new source to serve the water system located with a fully protected 100 foot radius.
