Right of the general public to the unrestricted use of all the waters of a navigable body of water, not only for the primary purposes of navigation, but also for corollary purposes, including (but not limited to) fishing, boating, bathing, swimming, water skiing and other related recreational purposes, as those waters may affect the tidelands, shorelands, or adjoining uplands, and whether the level of the water has been raised naturally or artificially to a maintained or fluctuating level, all as further defined by the decisional law of this state. (Affects all of the premises subject to such submergence.)
- J. Any prohibition or limitation on the use, occupancy of improvement of the land resulting from the Rights of the Public or Riparian Owners to use any waters, which may cover the land.
- K. Any adverse claim by reason of the question of location, boundary, or area of said land, which may be dependent upon the location of the line of ordinary high tide of Bellingham Channel.
- L. Any adverse claim based upon the assertion that any portion of said land was not shoreland subject to disposition by the State of Washington, or that any portion thereof has ceased to be shorelands by reason of erosion or by reason of having become upland by accretion.
