TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

The Grantor, EDWARD J. KAPTEIN AND CHERYL A. KAPTEIN, husband and wife, for and in consideration of MUTUAL BENEFITS, and other valuable consideration, conveys and grants unto the CITY OF MOUNT VERNON, a Municipal Corporation of the Sate of Washington, and it assigns, a Temporary Construction Easement over, under, upon and across the hereinafter described lands (hereinafter referred to as the "Construction Area.").

PURPOSE

GRANTEE and its assigns shall have the rights of ingress and egress to take whatever actions necessary within the **Construction Area** for reshaping and repairs to existing improvements affected by the City's project construction; and, to construct road improvements, including excavating, compacting, shaping and grading, sidewalk construction, constructing road works, matching driveway entrances, and miscellaneous construction, all costs of which shall be borne by the City of Mount Vernon.

GRANTORS' USE OF THE CONSTRUCTION AREA

GRANTORS shall have access to the Construction Area at all times except during the time actual construction activities are being carried out within the Construction Area.

RESTORATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION AREA

Following completion of the GRANTEE'S construction and related work in the Construction Area, GRANTEE shall, at GRANTEE'S expense, promptly restore Construction Area as nearly to and reasonably as possible to the condition in which it existed prior to such damage.

DAMAGE TO OTHER PROPERTY

If at any time after the execution of this agreement, the GRANTEE, in the exercise of the rights granted to the GRANTEE herein, shall damage any of the property owned by the GRANTORS which abuts and is outside of the Construction Area, the GRANTEE shall, at the GRANTEE'S expense, promptly restore any such property as nearly to and reasonably as possible to the condition in which it existed prior to such damage.

DURATION

The rights granted shall commence upon the GRANTORS' execution of this easement document and shall continue for a period of two years, or until the GRANTEE ceases to use the **Construction Area** for the purposes stated herein, whichever occurs first.




