Right to enter said premises to operate, maintain and repair underground electric transmission and/or distribution system, together with the right to remove brush, trees and landscaping which may constitute a

danger to said lines

A right -of -way 5 feet in width having 2.5 feet of such width on each side of a centerline described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line that is approximately 230 feet South of the Northeast corner thereof; thence West, a distance of 2.5 feet to the true point of beginning; thence South parallel with the East line approximately 110 feet to its terminus.
